

**Statement by Prof George Luchiri Wajackoyah in response to Halala USA's dissociation with his comments:**

California, March 11 2009

I hereby wish to state that I have never at any time been a self seeker as stated by my friend Pius Mwemba, the Halala USA President.

Paragraph 1 of his allegations is not denied.
