

## **Reverend Tim Wambunya**

The Board of Directors of Oxford Centre for Mission Studies is delighted to announce the appointment of the Reverend Tim Wambunya as the next Principal of Carlile College, taking over from Canon Dr David Williams who has been appointed Development and Training Secretary for the Church Missionary Society of Australia. Rev Tim Wambunya began his career as an officer in the Kenyan Navy. He was then accepted for ordination training in the Diocese of London of the Church of England and was ordained an Anglican Priest in 1998. He holds Bachelors and Masters degrees in Theology from Oak Hill Theological College, London. He expects to complete his PhD in Missiology through the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies during the course of this year. Rev Tim Wambunya has been involved in parish ministry in the United Kingdom for the last ten years. He also brings significant experience of mission in Africa through his extensive involvement in the African Institute for Contemporary Mission and Research. In addition, Tim is Chairman of the Kenya Church Association (UK and Kenya), is a panel member of the Church of England's "Partners in World Mission" and is a Council Member of Crosslinks. Tim brings particular skills in mission leadership, strategic development and fundraising. Rev Tim Wambunya is married to Gertrude and they have three children, Tim, Okari and David.
